Navy League Cadets are young boys and girls ages 9-13 and, unlike the Sea Cadets who are co-sponsored by both the Canadian Forces and Navy League, are administered solely by the Navy League of Canada. Sea Cadets may volunteer their time to assist with the instruction of the junior programme and in exchange, may collect volunteer hours that could be converted into high school credits. They also gain valuable instructional experience. Navy League Officers are uniformed, trained, screened and covered by the same general accident and liability insurance policy as the Sea and Navy League Cadets. Through a Memorandum of Understanding between the Navy League and Canadian Forces the practice of having Sea Cadets volunteer at Navy League Cadet Corps has been classified as an authorized Sea Cadet activity.
